about the work MLG and the Ministry of Lands and Natural Resources in Zambia is carrying out on the Land Titling Programme (NLTP) that is part of the country's 8th National Development Plan.



President Hakainde Hichilema said: "The objectives of NLTP is to guarantee security of tenure, promote internal security and increase the revenue base and investment in the country, thereby contributing to the social economic development of our nation.

Since the inception of this programme in October of 2020, 211,439 properties and landowner information has been captured in Lusaka and Copperbelt provinces.

Furthermore, throughout the month of May this year, Medici Land Governance team prepared for the starting of enumeration of properties in Luanshya and Mufulira Councils scheduled for the month of June 2022.

The programme is expected to be rolled out to the Central and North-Western Provinces in the next few months.

## CERTIFICATES OF TITLE

have so far been issued out by Ministry of Lands and Natural Resources to their respective property owners under the National Land Titling Programme as of May 31st, 2022.
